

On Sunday, April 9, 2017, the Standing Committee conducted their regular monthly meeting. In addition to regular reports and status updates, we heard the results of the recent congregational survey on stewardship and we talked about an upcoming leadership workshop.

At the request of the Nominating Committee, the Standing Committee voted to reduce the membership of the Nominating Committee from 9 people to 7 people over the next two years. The reduction in numbers reflects the current responsibilities of the board in comparison to the responsibilities of the board when the membership was expanded in the early 2000s.

Tom Wilson presented the results of the Stewardship survey. The stewardship responses describe a parish that is committed, energized and optimistic about our future. Those results will be shared with all interested congregants at 11:30am Sunday, April 23, 2017 in the sanctuary.
