Position Summary

Music plays an integral role in the spiritual and community life of First Parish in Concord. The Music Ministry of First Parish offers singers and instrumentalists of all ages and abilities opportunities to make music together and to minister to one another, the congregation, and the wider world through music.

The Contemporary Music Leader will lead the Contemporary Vocal Ensemble, an adult ensemble that provides music for regular Sunday morning worship services 4-5 times a year; and collaborate in planning and leading our monthly "Open Door" contemporary service, which currently meets on the first Tuesday evening 6:00-7:00 pm. The preferred candidate will also be able to provide keyboard or other accompaniment for the Youth Gospel Choir, which rehearses Sundays 9:00-9:45 am.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

Contemporary Vocal Ensemble

- Direct and recruit membership for Contemporary Vocal Ensemble, including a volunteer "house band" and vocalists (currently approximately 20 singers).
- Rehearse this group in preparation for four or five worship services between September and June.

- Choose and acquire repertoire appropriate for UU worship.
- Lead contemporary musicians during worship services.
- Engage outside musicians as needs and budget allow.
- Maintain current roster of members and communicate plans to membership through email, social media, newsletter, etc.

Worship

- With clergy, Director of Music Ministry, and other staff, plan and lead music for "Open Door" contemporary services, currently on the first Tuesday evening of each month, October through June.
- Accompany choirs, worship services, and other musical events as needed and negotiated.

Gospel Choir

 Provide keyboard or other accompaniment for the Youth Gospel Choir at weekly rehearsals and in 4-5 services per year, including Christmas Eve

Time Requirements:

- **Contemporary Vocal Ensemble:** Rehearse from 11:30 to 12:30 for approximately 16 Sundays, September June TBD.
- **Open Door:** Currently first Tuesday of the month, October June from approximately 5:00 to 7:30pm (service is at 6pm)
- **Gospel Choir Accompaniment (if included):** Sunday mornings mid-September thru mid-June 8:45 to 10am. 10am 11am on Sundays when Gospel Choir leads worship.

- Choral conducting or group song-leading skills

- Ability to work both on a team and to take personal initiative
