Update on New Photo Directories

We know that the wait for our new photo directories has been long, and we apologize for the delay. We finally received the proof of the directory from the company recently and have mailed it back with our final approval. Once they receive it, we were told it will take twenty days to produce the directories, and then they will be shipped to us. Therefore, we expect to receive the directories in early to mid-April. Please stay tuned for a notification when they've arrived. The First Parish Commission on Institutional Change (COIC) voted on March 16, 2024 to sunset our group, effective at the close of Annual Meeting 2024. Two and a half years ago, the Standing Committee gave us a charge to review all church politics, practices, and procedures and suggest ways to better align them with our UU values and our desire to both dismantle white supremacy and offer radical welcome. Members of the COIC believe we have fulfilled that charge to the best of our abilities. This does NOT mean our congregation is finished with its anti-oppression responsibilities. Some COIC suggested changes are already underway (Welcoming Walls, bylaw revision, etc.). Other suggestions were outlined in last year's report to the Standing Committee that is available online: https://firstparish.org/wp/wp-content/uploads/202 3/04/COIC report1 revised published 041623.p df. We will also issue a final report later this spring that will be available to the full congregation. And we plan to make a final presentation to the congregation.
